## Ten Years of Service

How did 10 years go so fast? Writing this letter is bittersweet for me. By serving on the Watertown Community Foundation Board I have experienced the joy of helping donors make a difference in our community. I've also learned about many of our nonprofit organizations and the good they do, as well as seen the Foundation grow in both assets and its impact.

Many know the story. The Foundation began in 1979 with a mere \$3,000 leftover from Watertown's Centennial celebration. Today, it has grown to approximately \$15.5 million. Grants, totaling nearly \$5.5 million, have been awarded by the Watertown Community Foundation to organizations and programs in Watertown which have touched all of us in one way or another.

Over the years, support has been given to the Boys & Girls Club, Lake Area Zoological Society, Lake Area Technical Institute, Watertown Concert Association, Beacon Center

(formerly Watertown Resource Center), Salvation Army, Joy Ranch, Mellette House and countless others. Some of my favorite grants include supporting Thursday Night Live, which brings live music to uptown Watertown, the Watertown Artwalk, and supporting H2O-20, the community's visioning process.

Even though my term as a board member has come to an end, my involvement with the Foundation as an advocate, donor and grateful Watertown resident will not. I look forward to seeing all the good in store for Watertown and the Foundation as it continues Looking Forward and Giving Back.

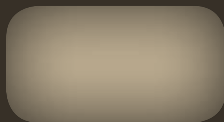

# Annual Grants

The numbers are in and they are exciting! The Watertown Community Foundation awarded a total of \$339,637 in 2014 grants and scholarships. The grants went to many deserving organizations and programs. The breakdown is as follows: \$170,926 to health and human services; \$120,217 to education; \$40,956 went to the arts and \$7,538 to environment.

Among the grants were:

## Arts & Culture

Grants supported South Dakota Symphony Concerts in Watertown; Thursday Night Live, public Holocaust survivor program, South Dakota's 125th celebration; Northeast Artists Network Deck the Walls; Northern Prairie Arts' Arts at the Pub; Town Players Youth Theater; and a grant to enable the Mellette Memorial Association to reprint 500 copies of The Civil War Diary of Arthur Calvin Mellette.

## Health & Human Services

Health & Human Services recipients included: 60s Plus Dining Program, PACH, McKinley Social Services, ICAP – Smile Mobile which provided more than \$20,000 in dental care during its local visit; Watertown Volunteer Center; Watertown Area Transit; Beacon Center; A Place at the Table; meals for athletes and volunteers at the Special Olympics track meet in Watertown; Big Brothers Big Sisters; Joy Ranch; Veterans' organizations; Lake Area Child Protection, Inc.; and the Boys & Girls Club.

## Education

Educational support included grants for: The LATI Governor's Luncheon; Middle College, Humanities book discussion; Parent University; Girls Night Out for 7th and 8th grade girls; Lake Area Zoological Society; as well as thousands of dollars in scholarships.

## Environment

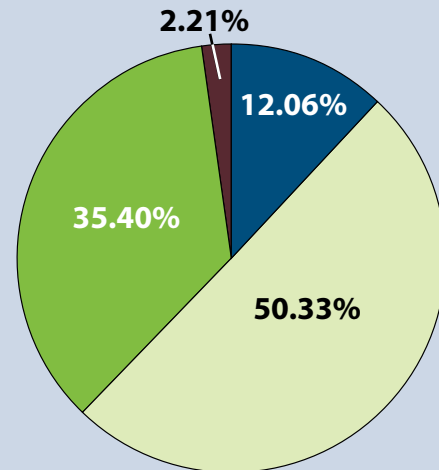
The environment was supported through grants to Lori's Garden; and Lake Area Zoological Society.

More than \$5,500,000 has been awarded in total grants since 1980. "Those dollars continue to make a positive impact in our community" said Jan DeBerg, WCF executive director. "On behalf of the Foundation's Board members and the grantees, thank you to our donors for making it possible."

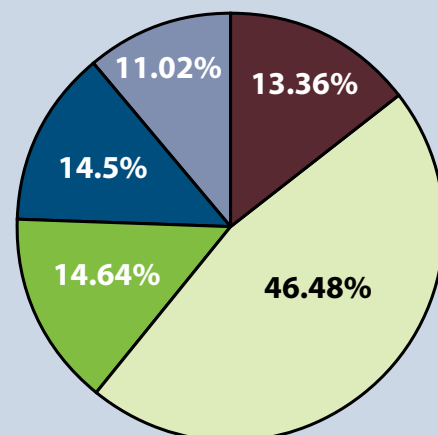
